I feel proud and honoured to chair this meeting and I very much hope that you will consider joining the international blood-brain barrier community, and possibly contributing to the program by submitting abstracts for oral or poster presentations. PhD students, graduate students, and junior researchers are welcome, and a significant number of short oral presentations will be selected from the abstracts submitted by young scientists. The deadline for abstract submission is May 28, 2020.
